
If the weather is clear, chances are good that you'll see the Aurora Borealis in the Northwest Territories on almost any night between mid-August and early April. Our Aurora specialists offer a truly exciting range of viewing experiences.

If you are an active traveller we have tours that zoom you along in a dogsled, with Aurora lighting your snowy path. If you prefer the maximum in exotic comfort, try a wilderness viewing deck equipped with heated seats that wrap you in warmth. Ride a snowmobile across a frozen lake, or fly by ski-plane to a cozy lodge where winter adventures pack your days and the Aurora performs at night. You can even watch the show from an outdoor hot tub.

During winter days try a snow slide or toboggan run, learn how to make aboriginal crafts, or snowshoe, cross country ski or snowmobile across awesome landscapes and watch for foxes, ptarmigan or even caribou. You can also experience the Aurora on the barrenlands, with our famous ice road truckers. Your thrilling journey on the world's longest winter road takes you to Canada's tundra diamond mining region.

Unique packages offered by Aurora operators include clothing rental for winter trips (down filled parkas, lined wind pants, boots, mitts and wool touques) and a range of options from two to seven days.
