
Visit historic Bear Rock in Great Bear Lake and learn the story of Yamouria, the legendary Dene hunter. On this one-day tour, you'll visit Arrow Site, Little Smokes and the place where Yamouria slew the giant beavers. Or trek through the Hammer and Franklin Mountains for sweeping views of the land. Possible wildlife sightings include Grizzly Bears, Caribou, Moose, Muskoxen, and Wolves. Other experiences such as canoeing, paddleboarding and camping in shoal tents are also available.



FISHING

PACKAGES START AT \$10,080 FISHING SEASON RUNS FROM JULY 01-SEPTEMBER 20

With 4-day and 7-day excursions, you'll travel by boat along the famed Mackenzie River, known as the Deh Cho or "Big River" around these parts, to Great Bear River before reaching Great Bear Lake. Or, opt instead for a fishing trip to the smaller and idyllic Kelly Lake, also up the Mackenzie, Great Bear and finally the Brackett Rivers. Fish for Pike, Walleye, Arctic Grayling, Whitefish, or really big Lake Trout. You might even set a new world record! This trip offers fantastic sightseeing opportunities and the possibility of such wildlife as Grizzly Bears, Muskoxen, Moose, Caribou and Wolves.

Experience the vibrant and traditional communities of the Sahtu via its sacred waters. Travel by river to Tulita, Délįnę, Fort Good Hope, Tsiighetchic, Wrigley, the confluence of the Mackenzie and Keele Rivers and the confluence of the Mackenzie and Mountain Rivers. Learn on the land skills and Dene cultural traditions as you take in the unique landscape of the region. These incredible sightseeing tours include the possibility of viewing Muskoxen, Moose, Caribou, Grizzly Bears and Wolves. Take your adventure to the next level with a boat tour to the Keele and Natla Rivers or Keele River and Caribou Flats. Cruise through the mountains among the stunning rugged landscape, home to incredible wildlife.
