Massive Northern Pike – up to 54 inches – prowl the many shallow, grassy bays. The islands and reef structure in Kasba are ideally suited to Lake Trout, that grow up to 56 pounds in these cold, clear waters. And the rivers and streams flowing into Kasba are brimming with world-record Arctic Grayling. KAZAN RIVER

A Canadian Heritage River, the Kazan River runs from Kasba Lake to Hudson's Bay and its fast-flowing rapids are teeming with Arctic Grayling, not to mention the giant Lakers who inhabit the river each spring in search of smaller prey.

EXPLORE THE BRADFORD LAKE

A narrow lake with large, shallow bays is what we call a "Pike Factory." If you're looking for action, this lake 30 miles southwest of Kasba Lake Lodge is the place to go.

ATZINGING LAKE

This lake on the Snowbird River System is full of idyllic islands and reefs and is largely untouched. This makes it a perfect spot for you to reel in trophy-sized Pike, Lake Trout and Arctic Grayling.

PIKEASAURUS LAKE

The name says it all. This lake located 20 miles south of Kasba Lake Lodge has produced some of the largest Northern Pikes even seen in the area. The beautiful bays and grassy river channels are the perfect place to chase the Pike of your dreams.
