11pm to 4am

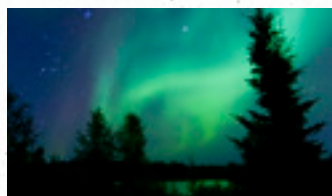

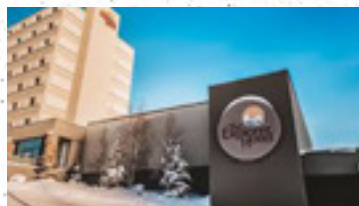

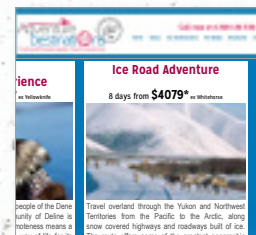
