1 Keep your eyes on the ground when visiting town. Enterprise is the place to spot fossilized footprints for a pre-historic walking fish – known as a *sarcopterygian*, above Alexandra Falls. Look for fossils at Twin Falls Gorge as well.

2 Just south of the community, a 2km forested trail connects the tiered, 15m-high Louise Falls with the splendid 33m-high Alexandra Falls along the Hay River. Get out and stretch your legs.
