WONDERFUL WOOD BUFFALO

Canada's largest national park, Wood Buffalo is home to some of the world's rarest and most impressive bird and animal species, as well as otherworldly salt plains and whitewater.



ENTHRALLING TWIN FALLS

At Twin Falls Gorge Territorial Park, north of the Alberta border, watch the Hay River plunge 32 metres at Alexandra Falls. A short hike downriver, behold breathtaking Louise Falls.



A GREAT LAKE ADVENTURE

Book a Great Slave Lake fishing tour in Hay River to get a look at the Lake Trout, Walleye, Whitefish, Northern Pike, Arctic Grayling and Burbot that call the lake home.



TEE OFF NORTH OF 60

Play until midnight at the Hay River Golf Course, laid out among picturesque stands of birch, or Fort Smith's Pelican Rapids Golf and Country Club, with scenic Slave River vistas.



RIDE THE RAPIDS

Grab a kayak and join the whitewater lovers at Slave River Rapids, a set of four rapids from mild to wild that starts at Fort Fitzgerald and ends at Fort Smith.
